ORIGINAL TEXT

Initial text unchanged

AMENDED TEXT

Recital 8a, after the 8th Recital, insert:

- whereas the COMETT Programme should be a tangible extension of social dialogue and open to both sides of industry in the spirit of the joint opinion of 6 March 1987 on the training and motivation of workers in the context of technological change;

new Recital 8b:

- whereas workers and students benefiting from operations under the COMETT Programme must not suffer disadvantage thereby, particularly as regards their labour rights, their rights to social security and sickness insurance or their educational rights, as appropriate;

New Recital 9a after the 9th recital:

- whereas the COMETT Programme must take greater account of the needs of regions which have greater difficulty in taking part in the COMETT Programme and in which cooperation between universities and undertakings is still at a low level of development, in order to allow balanced participation in the Programme by the different regions;

insert new Recital 9b

- whereas the important restructuring changes under way in the technological and industrial spheres and the establishment of undertakings in technologically advanced sectors create a need for in-service vocational training schemes in the context of regional cooperation between universities and undertakings;
