THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community,

Having regard to the Act of Accession,

Having regard to the proposal from the Commission,

Whereas the Council adopted, on 3 November 1976, a set of resolutions
concerning certain external and internal aspects of the common fisheries
policy;

Whereas consultations have taken place between the Community and Norway in
order to establish the reciprocal fishing rights of the two parties for the
year 1978 and that these consultations have not yet been completed;

Whereas meanwhile the two Parties have agreed on certain provisional arrangements
and it is necessary to take measures to implement these arrangements;

Whereas the Community and Canada have agreed to coordinate their fisheries
policy concerning certain joint fish and shrimp stocks located in the Lardies
Strait and Baffin Bay (ICNAF Zones 0 and 1);

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION :

... ..

Article 1

1. The only catches which vessels flying the flag of Norway shall be authorized to take within the 200 nautical mile fishery zone of Denmark situated off the coast of Greenland and covered by Community rules on fisheries are laid down in the Annex.
2. The fishing quotas shall be granted subject to compliance with the conservation and surveillance measures and all other provisions governing fishing in the zones referred to in paragraph 1,

Article 2

Fishing within the zones referred to in Article 1 shall be subject to the granting of a licence by the Commission on behalf of the Community, and to observance of the conditions set out in the licence.

Article 3

When an application for a licence is submitted to the Commission the following information shall be supplied ;

- a) name of the vessel,
- b) registration number,
- c) external identification letters and numbers,
- d) port of registration,
- e) name and address of the owner or charterer,
- f) gross tonnage and overall length,
- g) engine power,
- h) call sign and radio frequency,
- i) intended methods of fishing,
- j) intended area of fishing,
- k) species which it is intended to fish,
- l) period for which a licence is requested.

Article 4

Each licence shall be valid for one vessel only. When several vessels are taking part in the same fishing operation, each vessel must be in possession of a licence.

Article 5

1. The licence holder shall be required to comply with the conditions of the licence and to notify a radio station in the Member States at the times stipulated in the licence, especially including details of the vessel's position and the catch of each species.
2. The Member States radio stations shall immediately notify the Commission directly of messages transmitted by the fishing vessels of non-member countries in compliance with the licence.

Article 6

Member States shall take all possible steps to ensure the enforcement of Article 1 in respect of the maritime waters coming under their sovereignty or falling under their jurisdiction, including the regular inspection of vessels.

Article 7

Within 24 hours of detecting any infringement Member States shall inform the Commission of the name of the vessel involved and details of the action they have taken.

Article 8

This regulation shall enter into force on the day following its publication in the Official Journal of the European Communities.

This regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
