REGULATION (EEC) OF THE COUNCIL

on intervention in colza and rape seed harvested in Denmark and the United Kingdom

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

From 1 February 1973 colza and rape seed harvested in the Member States of the enlarged Community will circulate freely between the original and the new Member States.

The fact that the intervention prices in Denmark and the United Kingdom were fixed at a level considerably lower than that of the prices applicable in the other Member States leads to the possibility that seed harvested in those countries, having low intervention prices, may be offered for intervention in Member States where the price in question is higher.

To prevent this from happening it should be provided that colza and rape seed harvested in the United Kingdom and in Denmark shall be offered for intervention only in the country of origin.

REGULATION (EEC) OF THE COUNCIL

on intervention in colza and rape seed harvested in Denmark and the United Kingdom.

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community;
Having regard to Council Regulation No 136/66/EEC (1) of 22 September 1966 on the establishment of a common organization of the market in oils and fats, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 1547/72 (2), and in particular Article 36 thereof;

Having regard to the proposal from the Commission;

Whereas the intervention prices operative in Denmark and the United Kingdom from 1 February 1973, fixed by Regulation (EEC) No 2496/72 (3), are lower than those applicable in the other Member States; whereas it could thus happen that seed harvested in Denmark and the United Kingdom would be offered for intervention in Member States where the said prices are higher; whereas this could lead to disorganized market conditions; whereas intervention should therefore be restricted, in Denmark and the United Kingdom, to colza and rape seed harvested in each of those countries, as long as the intervention prices applicable in those two Member States remain lower than those applicable in the other Member States;

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION :

Article 1

1. Colza and rape seed harvested in Denmark may be offered for intervention in the territory of that State only,
2. Colza and rape seed harvested in the United Kingdom may be offered for intervention in the territory of that State only.

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on the day following its publication in the Official Journal of the European Communities.

It shall apply from 1 February 1973.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
