

COUNCIL DECISION

of 4 October 1982

appointing the Greek members and alternate members of the Advisory Committee on the Training of Dental Practitioners

(82/679/EEC)

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to Council Decision 76/688/EEC of 25 July 1978 setting up an Advisory Committee on the Training of Dental Practitioners⁽¹⁾, and in particular Articles 3 and 4 thereof,

Whereas, under Article 3 of that Decision, the Advisory Committee on the Training of Dental Practitioners consists of three experts from each Member State and an alternate member for each of those experts; whereas under Article 4 of that Decision the term of office of these experts and alternate members is three years;

Whereas the Hellenic Republic acceded to the European Communities on 1 January 1981; whereas experts and alternate members should therefore be appointed to represent the Hellenic Republic on the said Committee;

Whereas, by Decision 80/376/EEC of 26 March 1980⁽²⁾, the Council appointed the members and alternate members of the Advisory Committee on the Training of Dental Practitioners for the period 26 March 1980 to 25 March 1983;

Whereas the experts and alternate members designated by the Hellenic Republic should be appointed until 25 March 1983,

HAS DECIDED AS FOLLOWS:

Sole Article

The following have been appointed as Greek members and alternate members of the Advisory Committee on the Training of Dental Practitioners until 25 March 1983:

A. Experts from the practising profession of dentistry*Member:* Mr Brice Guy*Alternate member:* Mr Viglas Panayiotis**B. Experts from the relevant faculties of the universities or comparable institutions***Member:* Mr Mitsis Fotis*Alternate member:* Mr Iacovidis Dimitrios**C. Experts from the competent authorities of the Member States***Member:* Mrs S. Kouri-Sarofonitou*Alternate member:* Mrs A. Frentzou.
