of 6 November 1973

Advisory Committee of the Euratom Supply Agency

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to Article X of the Statutes of the Euratom Supply Agency ⁽¹⁾, as amended by the Council Decision of 8 March 1973 ⁽²⁾ ;

Having regard to the proposals from Denmark, Ireland and the United Kingdom ;

Having regard to the Opinion of the Commission ;

Whereas, according to the terms of Article 148 (1) of the Act of Accession ⁽³⁾, the terms of office of the new members of the Advisory Committee of the Euratom Supply Agency shall expire at the same time as those of the members in office at the time of Accession,
